

# November 2010 SSCE Net-letter

Hard to believe that the 2010 Camping season is just about over for most of us. Time to clean out your campers, prepare them for winter storage and think about next years camping adventures.

Some tips I have heard about recently to pass along....

- L66 door handles: do not over tighten the 4 screws that hold the handle to the door. This causes the lock to stick and your key wont be able to unlock it once locked....
- Keep snow from piling up around your camper during winter storage as the wood will wick up the wet snow and cause the sides to rot....
- Check your roof vent area for signs of seal issues and use Eternabond RV tape to reseal areas around the vent and roof seams....
- Make sure to check for mice access holes on the underside of the camper. Put moth balls and dryer sheets inside the camper for winter storage. I heard that a few charcoal grill briquettes will help as well. Nothing wrong with trying these out to see how they work for you.
